

GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

- 1. The Government of the Republic of The Gambia has received an African Development Fund (ADF) grant in the amount of UA 10 million and Transitional Support Facility (TSF) Pillar 1 grant in the amount of UA 5 million from the African Development Bank (AfDB) to finance the Banjul Port 4th Expansion Project.
- 2. The principal objectives of this project are to enhance The Gambia's regional competitiveness and ensure climate resilience of the Port of Banjul. The specific development objectives include: (i) reduce the ship waiting time, avoid costly congestion, surcharges, facilitate reduction in sea freight costs and demurrage payments at the Banjul Port; (ii) provide additional capacity to meet the present and future forecast levels of traffic requirements including container traffic; (iii) improve Port efficiency, operations and management by renewed and digitalized procedures and computerization; (iv) facilitate improved traffic flow in and around the access roads leading to the Port and make the road climate-resilient; and (v) maintain cost-effective and reliable ferry services by introducing green and low emitting ferries.
- 3. The project includes the following components:
- (i) Component A. Climate Resilient Port Expansion and Modernization: This component will involve construction of Port infrastructure and facilities, including: (1) a climate-resilient Jetty Extension by 345m based on the Length Over All (LOA) of vessels calling at the Port of Banjul and the need to accommodate three (3) vessels simultaneously; (2) climate-smart rehabilitation of existing terminal and new climate-resilient construction of a modern container terminal and gate complex; (3) climate-resilient relocation of the Banjul ferry terminal; (4) supervision of works for Jetty and container terminal; and (5) Land acquisition and relocation of Project Affected Persons (PAPs).
- (ii) Component B. Transport and Trade Facilitation: This will involve construction of road infrastructure, including: (1) procurement of a new green ferry for Banjul/Barra Crossing points; (2) implementation of Authorized Economic Operators program and interconnections between Customs and Terminal Operation System; and (3) deployment of trade facilitation measures/establishment of a GPA Port Management System components to empower GPA support and access national single window currently under development by Gambia Revenue Authority; and (4) training/change management; and (5) setting up of early warning system for climate hazards.
- (iii) Component C. Ancillary Activities: This component will involve the construction of road infrastructure, including: (1) climate proofing completion and widening of bund road access to the Port; and (2) supervision of Works for bund road and ferry terminal relocation.
- (iv) Component D. Institutional Support and Project Management: This component will support strengthening the capacity of the Grantee and monitoring the implementation of components A, B and

C, including: (1) acquisition of a consultant for climate resilient transport master plan; (2) consultancy services; (3) technical support assistant to the Ministry of Transport, Works and Infrastructure; and (4) Project management support in the area of Audit services, Procurement, Environmental and Social Management.

- 4. Procurement of goods, works and the acquisition of consultancy services financed under the project, will be carried out in accordance with the "Procurement Policy and Methodology for the African Development Bank Group Funded Operations" (BPM), dated October 2015. Bidding documents are expected to be available in August 2023.
